GENERAL INFORMATION—SENIOR HIGH**

Directions to Camp: Rushmore Music Camp will be held at Camp Judson, located 3 miles west of Keystone, SD, on the Keystone-Hill City County Road #353. The camp can be reached from either Keystone or Hill City. If you are coming from Rapid City, take Mt. Rushmore Road, Highway 16A to Keystone. Turn west at the stop light at the entrance to Keystone and go west 3 miles to Camp Judson. From Hill City, take the Old Hill City Road, the second right, coming from downtown Hill City.

Registration: Plan to arrive and register between 2:30 and 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 6. Registration will be held inside the Main Lodge area. If the registration line is long, you may get your housing assignment first, get settled in your cabin, and warm up for your audition(s). You will be assigned an audition time in the registration line, and auditions should be completed by 5:00 p.m. **Bring an etude, exercise, or part of a solo for auditions.**

IMPORTANT: If you have registered for camp and find that you are unable to attend, please call Peggy Letcher immediately. If you have questions or concerns, please contact Peggy Letcher by e-mail at jletcher@nvc.net or call (605) 229-5714 and leave a message.

Note to Parents: Meals and lodging are only available to registered campers.

Fees: The camp fee is \$375.00 (which includes board and room, one private lesson & camp t-shirt). Additional lessons are \$15.00 each. **There is a \$30.00 non-refundable processing fee with the registration.** You may pay the total fee in advance or submit the \$100.00 deposit and pay the remainder at registration. Make checks payable to: RUSHMORE NATIONAL MUSIC CAMP. If you are receiving a scholarship from your school, band booster organization or music club, please send it in advance or bring it with you on registration day. Rushmore Music Camp scholarship recipients will be notified by mail.

SAVE TIME—PAY IN ADVANCE. All fees must be paid in full at registration time.

Private Lessons: All students will receive one private lesson. Additional private lessons are available and will be given by specialists. Fees for additional private lessons are \$15.00 per 30-minute lesson. Two private lessons are recommended on each instrument. Students are requested to bring method book(s) and or solo(s) to camp.

Performances: Student Talent Night will be held on Thursday, August 11th at 7:00 p.m. at Camp Judson. **Jazz Night** featuring the Rushmore Singers, Modern Dance Classes, and Jazz Bands will be held at the Mt. Rushmore Amphitheater on Friday evening, August 11, at 7:05 p.m. The **Final Concert** will be Saturday, August 12, at 11:00 a.m. at the Mt. Rushmore Amphitheater. Parents, relatives and friends are welcome to attend the concerts. All concerts at Mt. Rushmore are free and open to the public. There is a charge for parking at Mt. Rushmore.

Check Out: All students are required to stay until the conclusion of the Final Concert Saturday. **Cabin inspection will be held during breakfast on Saturday. Campers may not check out until their cabins have passed inspection.** Parents should pick up campers no later than 9:30 am. After cabins have passed inspection students may load their luggage and leave for Mt. Rushmore. All campers should be seated in the Mt. Rushmore Amphitheater by 10:00 am.

WHAT TO BRING CHECK LIST Senior High Camp

CONCERT DRESS: Concert attire will be Camp t-shirt & khaki slacks/capris. (NO SHORTS PLEASE.)

CLOTHING:

- Informal clothes—jeans, shorts, etc.
- Rain jacket
- Tan khaki slacks/capris (for concerts)
- Swim suit
- Sweater or jacket (evenings are cool)
- Pajamas
- Bathrobe (showers are separate)
- Comfortable hiking shoes
- Sun visors, sunglasses & sunscreen
- Shower shoes or flip-flops

EQUIPMENT:

- Your instrument
- Music stand labeled with your name
- Flashlight
- Music for lessons--books/solos
- Camera—if desired
- Notebook for classes
- Pencil and pen/stationary/stamps
- Talent selections with accompaniment

PERSONAL ARTICLES:

- Comb/brush
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Soap & Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Wash cloth & towels
- Secure storage for money

BEDDING:

- a blanket or a sleeping bag
- Single bed sheets (bring one fitted or regular sheet to protect mattress)
- Pillow and case

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Percussion players should bring sticks, snare drum/stand.
- Money for optional purchases (Camp Picture \$5; Compact Disc Recording of Final Concert, approximately \$15)
- Trumpet, tuba, euphonium & trombone players should bring mutes and slide preparation/valve oil.
- Single Reed players should bring at least 4 reeds.
- Double Reed players should bring 3 working reeds. (Bring reed-making equipment if possible.)

Note: There will be a \$10 fee for double reed-making class payable at registration.
