**Directions to Camp:** *Rushmore Junior High Music Camp* will be held at **Northern State University, Aberdeen, SD.** The campus is located at **1200 South Jay Street, Aberdeen, SD 57401**  
<http://northern.edu/about/map.html>.

**Registration:** Registration will be held in the Johnson Fine Arts Center. There is parking in the lot adjacent to the JFAC on the east side. Plan to arrive and register between 1:30 and 3:30 PM on Sunday, August 2. You will be given directions for finding your residence hall and room during registration. You will also be assigned an audition time in the registration line, and auditions should be completed by 4:30 p.m. ***Bring an etude, exercise or part of a solo for auditions.***

**Important:** If you have registered for camp and find that you are unable to attend, please call camp registrar Peggy Letcher immediately. **A deposit of \$100 is required at the time of application. A portion of the deposit (\$30) is a non-refundable processing fee. **Note to Parents:** Meals and lodging are available only to registered campers.

**Note to Day Campers:** ***DAY CAMPERS WILL BE EXPECTED TO EAT ALL MEALS AT CAMP. Announcements are made at all meals, so it is imperative that Day Campers be present at ALL meals.***

**Fees:** All fees must be paid in full at registration time. Make checks payable to: **RUSHMORE NATIONAL MUSIC CAMP.** The **camp fee is \$460.00** (includes tuition, room and board, one private lesson, camp picture, camp T-shirt, and CD of final concert) If you wish to stay off campus, the fee for **day campers is \$395.00** (includes tuition, 15 meals, one private lesson, camp picture, camp T-shirt and CD of final concert). Additional lessons are \$20.00 each. You may pay the total fee in advance or submit the \$100.00 deposit and pay the remainder at registration ***If you are receiving a scholarship from your school or music club, please send it in advance or bring it with you on registration day.*** Please be sure the scholarship is made payable to: Rushmore National Music Camp. Any student who was chosen for Junior High/Middle School All-State Band, is eligible for a \$25 scholarship. See on Camp Application form fees. **Save Time—Pay in Advance:** Your time in the registration line will be much shorter if you pay fees in advance.

**Dorm Fee:** A key deposit for your dormitory room will NOT be required from campers, staff or faculty when you check into your residence hall room. However, there is a \$25 fee required if the key is lost.

**Private Lessons:** All students will receive one private lesson on the student's MAIN BAND INSTRUMENT (included in the tuition). Specialists teach private lessons, and at least one additional lesson on the student's main band instrument is recommended. Fees for additional private lessons are \$20.00 per 30-minute lesson. **Two** private lessons are recommended on the student's main instrument (one included in tuition, the second for a \$20 fee). Students may register for one or two additional lessons on another instrument or voice for a **total** of three or four lessons. Students are requested to bring method book(s) and or solo(s) to camp.
