Directions to Camp Judson: Rushmore Music Camp will be held at Camp Judson, located 3 miles west of Keystone, SD, on the Keystone-Hill City County Road #353. The camp can be reached from either Keystone or Hill City. If you are coming from Rapid City, take Mt. Rushmore Road, Highway 16A to Keystone. Turn west at the stop light at the entrance to Keystone and go west 3 miles to Camp Judson. From Hill City, take the Old Hill City Road, the second right, coming from downtown Hill City.

Registration: Plan to arrive and register between 2:30 and 4:00 PM on Sunday, August 9. Registration will be held inside the Main Lodge area. If the registration line is long, you may get your housing assignment first, get settled in your cabin, then register and warm up for your audition(s). You will be assigned audition times in the registration line, and auditions should be completed by 5:00 PM. **Bring an etude, exercise, or part of a solo for the audition(s).**

Fees: All fees must be paid in full at registration time. Make checks payable to: **RUSHMORE NATIONAL MUSIC CAMP**. The **camp fee is \$495.00** (includes tuition, housing, meals, one private lesson, camp T-shirt, camp picture, and CD of final concert). Additional lessons are \$20.00 each. You may pay the total fee in advance or submit the required \$100.00 deposit and pay the remainder at registration. **If you are receiving a scholarship from your school, band booster organization, or music club, please send it in advance, or bring it with you on registration day.** Please be sure the scholarship is made payable to: Rushmore National Music Camp. Any student who was chosen for All-State Band, All-State Orchestra, All-State Jazz Band or Honors Choir is eligible for a \$25 scholarship. See on Camp Application form fees. Important: If you have registered for camp and find that you are unable to attend, please call Camp Registrar Peggy Letcher immediately. **A deposit of \$100 is required at the time of application. A portion of the deposit (\$30) is a non-refundable processing fee. Note to parents: ***Meals and lodging are available only to registered campers.***

Save Time – Pay in Advance: All fees must be paid in full at registration time.

Private Lessons: All students will receive one private lesson ON THEIR MAIN BAND INSTRUMENT (OR VOICE IN MUSICAL THEATER CAMP) included in the tuition. Specialists teach private lessons, and additional lessons are recommended. Fees for additional private lessons are \$20.00 per 30-minute lesson. Two private lessons per student are recommended, (one included in tuition, the second for \$20) to maximize the opportunity to study with a specialist. Students may register for one or two additional lessons on another instrument or voice for a TOTAL of three or four lessons. Campers should bring method book(s), solo(s), and/or other lesson materials to camp.

Parents, relatives and friends are invited to attend these performances. All concerts at Mt. Rushmore are free and open to the public, however there is a charge for parking at Mt. Rushmore.

Check Out: All students are required to stay until the conclusion of the Final Concert on Friday evening. Parents wishing to pick up their son/daughter on Friday evening may check their son/daughter out of camp prior to the concert. **Arrangements for early check-out must be made with the Camp Director, Al LaFave, on or before registration on Sunday, August 9.** If you have questions, please email the Camp Director, alan.lafave@vcs.edu.

Unless a parent or guardian has made prior arrangements with the Camp Director, students are expected to stay at camp for cabin inspection, final check-out and breakfast on Saturday morning,

WHAT TO BRING CHECK LIST:

Rushmore National Music Camp--Senior High

CONCERT DRESS: Concert attire will be Camp T-shirt & BLACK slacks / capris.
(NO SHORTS PLEASE)

For long-time campers: please remember that the camp uniform has changed to BLACK PANTS!

CLOTHING:

- Informal clothes—jeans, shorts, etc.
- Rain jacket/umbrella
- BLACK slacks/capris (for concert)
- Hoodie/sweatshirt/light jacket
- Shower shoes or flip-flops
- Pajamas
- Bathrobe (some showers are separate)
- Hiking shoes/athletic shoes/tennis shoes
(Only campers who have shoes that offer protection and support for hiking will be allowed to hike)

BEDDING:

ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

- Percussion players should bring sticks, mallets and a practice pad.
- Money for snacks from the camp store.
- Trumpet, tuba, euphonium & trombone players should bring mutes and slide preparation/valve oil.
- Single Reed players should bring at least 4 reeds.
- Double Reed players should bring 3 working reeds. (Bring reed-making equipment if possible.)

Note: There will be a \$10 fee for double reed-making class payable at registration.
